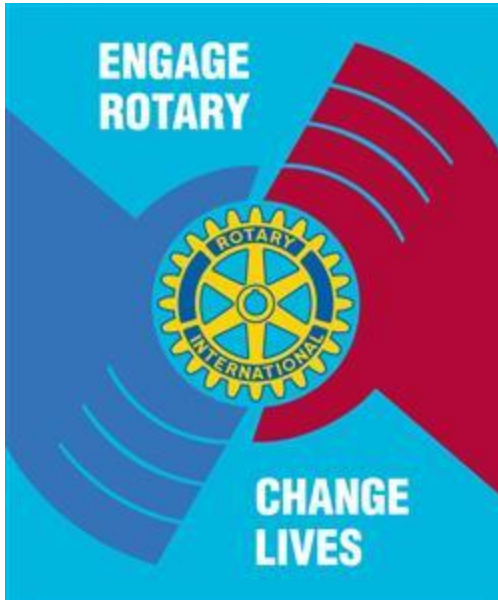

The Foundation has different aims than a Scholarship. The applicant must live in the 0870 to 0872 postcode areas. The criteria are about needs and commitment to goals. Rotary Clubs of Alice started the foundation with generous donations as a commitment for three years.

Through co-funding the foundation was able to turn every \$1 donated into \$3, and two grants totalling \$50,000 each year were made.
